

Connecting and Using the SZA-1

Basic Connection:

- Increasingly, televisions and other devices are providing digital audio outputs. Use the DAC-1 (Digital-to-Analog Converter) to convert the digital information into an analog signal necessary for whole-house audio distribution.
- Works great with Apple TV[®] as well as other devices with either an optical or digital coax output. Optical and digital coax cables sold separately. See the diagrams below for more information about these uses.

Diagram 1*





Diagram 1 shows how to integrate the SZA-1 into an HTD wholehouse audio setup. In this example, the SZA is providing amplification to a subzone.

Diagram 2 shows how the SZA can be used to accept the audio output from a device (in this case, a TV) that you wish to be amplified.
