BT-Player1

Front



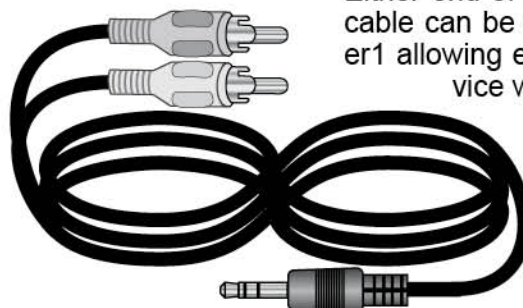
Rear



This is a full-frequency (20 Hz - 20 kHz) quality Bluetooth stereo receiver/player. Wirelessly pair any A2DP compatible device, such as an iPhone or other smart phone, to this Bluetooth player and stream your music into an amplifier or whole-house audio system.

Each player has a 30 foot range and a unique identifying code so multiple units can be used within the same house.

3.5mm/RCA Cable



Either end of this 3.5mm to RCA stereo cable can be connected to the BT-Player1 allowing easy connection to any device with a 3.5mm or RCA audio input.

Connecting and Using the BT-Player1

Basic Connection:

- BT-Player1 was designed with flexibility in mind. It can be integrated into a complete whole-house audio system such as the HTD Lync system, connected to a stereo amplifier, or connected to a home theater receiver. These are the most common uses. See the diagrams below for more information about these uses.

- The BT-Player1 must be paired with the smart device from which you are sending audio. BT-Player1 will appear as "Audio Adapter" with four numbers following it (ex: Audio Adapter 0279) within your bluetooth pairing list. This number is used for identification in the situation that you have more than one BT-Player1 connected to your system. For more information about bluetooth pairing with your smart device, please see your device's owner's manual.

- It is important to keep in mind that the MAXIMUM distance from smart device to the BT-Player1 should be no more than 30 feet. The connection is best maintained by not moving the smart device during operation.

Diagram 1

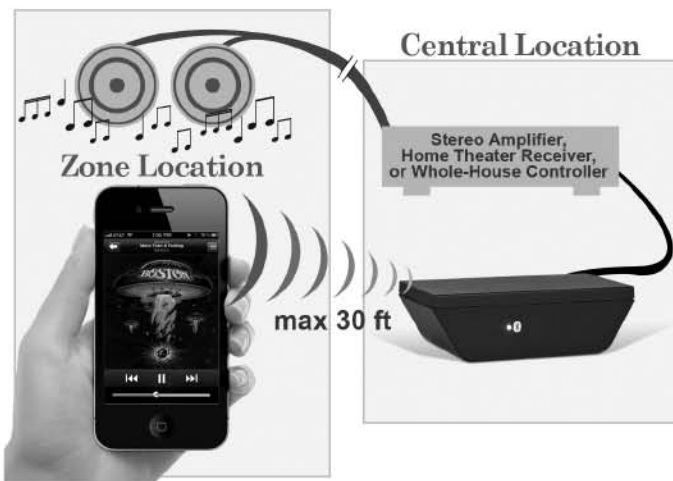


Diagram 1 shows a smartphone paired with the BT-Player1. The BT-Player1 is connected to a stereo amplifier (or home theater receiver, or any whole house audio controller) that accepts external audio inputs.

Diagram 2

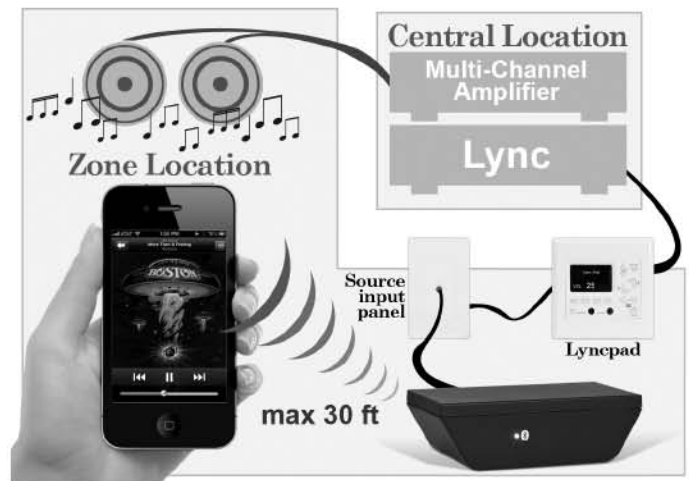


Diagram 2 shows a smartphone located within a zone paired with the BT-Player1 which is located in or near the same zone. The BT-Player1 is connected to an HTD Lync Whole-house Audio Controller via a Source Input Panel connected to a Lyncpad.
